1. Adhere to all Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District and State well restrictions for water wells.
2. Adhere to all well completion standards as set forth by 16 TAC76 and Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District Regulations (on back).
3. NOTIFY Development Management Department 24 hours before drilling well.
4. NOTIFY Kendall County Management Department the day and time of casing and cementing.
5. Supply a copy of State well report within 60 days after completion and plugging reports with 30 days after plugging.
6. Permission granted for Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District Representatives to enter property for the sole purpose to perform inspections, investigations regarding this application or consequent health problems arising.
7. THE PROPERTY OWNER OR IT'S DESIGNATED AGENT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOCATING THE WELL BOREHOLE SITE AND ALL PROPERTY LINES NECESSARY FOR KENDALL COUNTY TO RECORD IT'S LOCATION, PRIOR TO THE COW CREEK GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT'S WELL INSPECTOR VISITING THE SITE.
- \* 8. Shall comply with permitting requirements set forth by the Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District Title 2, Texas Water Code, Chapter 36, Sections 36.113 (Permit for Wells) and 36.117 (Exemptions).
- \*\* 9. Adhere to all well completion standards as set forth by TAC290 for Public Wells and Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District Regulations.

Please be advised that the sole responsibility for obtaining water analysis rests with the property owner and/or designated agent. In no event shall the district, its employees or agents be liable for direct, indirect, special, consequential or incidental damages, of any nature, resulting from, or in any way connected with the quality and quantity of water obtained from any water well drilled in Kendall County, Texas.
